CÓRDOBA

Come with us to discover the magical mixture of cultures in Cordoba, the city where past and modernity blend in together.



INCLUDED:

You will start this full guided tour from your pick up point in the Costa del Sol to Cordoba via the town of Antequera. On arrival, you will get a panoramic visit to the Roman Bridge and the Jewish Quarter, Synagogue and the Great Mosque (the most famous monument of the Islamic West, built over an old mosque, incorporating the Christian Basilica of Saint Vincent).

La Juderia (the Jewish Quarter) is the best-known part of Cordoba's historic center. It is also one of Europe's largest urban areas declared World Heritage Site. A fascinating neighborhood which dates from the late middle Ages full of narrow streets and reminders of the Jewish population that once lived here







Later in the day, you will also visit the Great Mosque of Cordoba, built during the period of Moorish occupation, and later converted into a Catholic Christian Cathedral. It is the most splendid Islamic monument in the western world and symbol of the city. Originally built as a mosque in 786, it is a harmonious combination of various different styles. Explore this beautiful building and marvel at the colorful mosaics and stained-glass windows.



You will also have some free time for lunch and to take a stroll through the historic quarter of Cordoba on your own.







SEVILLA

Enjoy Seville, the capital of Andalusia, and its beautiful architecture influenced by the Romans, Arabs and Jews throughout history. Join us and you will experience this warm and welcoming city.

This full guided tour will take you to the historic downtown of Seville. We will start with a panoramic visit of the city: Paseo de Colon, Plaza de America, Avenida de las Palmeras, Maria Luisa Park and Guadalquivir River. The city is situated on the banks of the Guadalquivir River, which divides the city into two halves: Sevilla and Triana.

Afterwards, we will make a stop at Plaza de España where you will have some free time to take beautiful photos. Again on our coach we go to the Jardines de Murillo. From here, we'll go around through narrow and serpentine streets with a secret and peaceful atmosphere. This is the Barrio de Santa Cruz (Jewish Quarter), one of the most charming parts of the city.





The visit continues to the splendid Cathedral. The Cathedral of Seville is the third largest church in the world after Saint Peter's in Rome and Saint Paul's in London. It is from the fifteenth century and occupies the site of a former great mosque built in the late twelfth century.



Finally, you'll have some free time to have lunch and to discover local food on your own.



Our meeting point before we come back is the famous Torre Del Oro, a thirteenth century tower, the top of which is rumored to have once been covered in gold





GRANADA WITH ALHAMBRA GARDENS

Discover the beautiful city of Granada, land of the Alhambra and of the marvelous Generalife Gardens, the gardens area attached to the Alhambra, which became a place of recreation and rest for the Granada Muslim Kings and its Alcazaba a world of Heritage Site.

We will visit the Charles V Palace, a Renaissance building located on the top of the hill of the Assabica, inside the Nasrid fortification of the Alhambra. The building has never been a home to a monarch and stood roofless until 1957.







Once we have finished our visit, we will be guided to the Granada historical city center to explore the surroundings of the Royal Chapel, the Alcaiceria, Corral del Carbon, Cathedral, etc....



The guide will offer you free time to enjoy the famous gastronomy, the called "tapas" until the return.








RONDA

Upon arrival, you will enjoy a sightseeing guided tour of its main attractions including Puerta de Almocabar (Almocabar Gate), Iglesia del Espiritu Santo (Church of the Holy Spirit), Town Hall Square, and Iglesia de Santa Maria la Mayor (Church of Santa Maria la Mayor).

We will continue with a full visit of the Plaza de Toros de la Maestranza, one of the oldest bullrings in Spain and also the site of some of the most important events in bullfighting history.

It is considered the birthplace of traditional bullfighting and also home of the world known Goyesca bullfight, where the decoration

and the clothing of bullfighters and spectators brings us to the age of the famous painter Goya. You will also enjoy the visit of the bullfighting museum inside.







Later on, we will go to a local winery called Bodegas La Sangre de Ronda. This is a wine museum that explores the historical and cultural impact that wine has had on this region. You will have the opportunity to taste some local wines.

Free time for lunch and to discover the city at leisure before we drive you back to your pick up point in the Costa del Sol. On our way back, we will make a short stop of about 45 minutes at Marbella's city center for you to go for a walk and take some pictures.







NERJA & FRIGILIANA

We will start in the morning direction Frigiliana, a beautiful and typical Andalusian village

Later on, we will depart for Nerja. Originally this was a small fishing village, and now it has become one of the most popular destinations in Malaga.

In the old town you will walk through its winding streets and cobbled pathways mixed with boutiques and restaurants with a backdrop of the beautiful Sierra Almijara Mountains. You will also have the opportunity to enjoy the breathtaking views from the Balcon de Europa.

We will also offer you the possibility of visiting the caves of Nerja, prehistoric caves with impressive rooms and galleries (optional and not included in price).

goods in the stores on the famous Main Street. Among famous the British and shop international names you'll find many local shops. Once you have been picked up from your hotel, you will travel along the Costa del Sol all the way to Gibraltar where you will have free time to explore its many shops. Buy at good prices sunglasses, cigarettes,



jewelry, watches, porcelain, perfumes, designer clothes and unique handicraft.



FERRATA GAUCÍN + VISIT VILLAGE | GAUCÍN (MIDDLE LEVEL)

We combine a small touristic visit to the white village of Gaucin and his castle with the adventure of climbing the walls of his beautiful cliff, place just in front of the deep Genal Valley, from where you can contemplate Gibraltar and the African coast.

It is a fantastic and complete Vía Ferrata with the longest zip installed in Andalusia (32 meters). It has as well one of the more sensational aerial views increased with the different suspended bridges we will cross.

We can be combined this Activity with the Vía Ferrata of Benalauría & Benadalid due of his proximity.

FERRATA CAMORRO | ANTEQUERA (MIDDLE - TÉCNIC LEVEL)

Situated on the north border of El Torcal Park of Antequera, Camorro is a very complete Ferrata which demands a minimum of physical fitness or previous experience having accomplished a Via Ferrata. It has a vertical first stretch including a couple of technical steps and the second stretch extend as a spectacular crossing offering us very aerial views over the valley. Nearly at the end of the first length is found an additional incentive, a zipp traverse of 8 meters over a deep ravine.

NARROWNESS CANYON | BENAHAVIS (EASY LEVEL)

Very close to Marbella, is an ideal canyon for initiation to this exciting sport.

In beautiful natural surroundings, you will learn the basic progression techniques for canyoning accessible to all. From the start, and always for those who wish to, you will enjoy jumps from different heights to a deep water reservoir in an idyllic location surrounded by mountains. Those who still don't feel daring enough for the small jumps, will be able to opt for a fun toboggan (...).

RONDA (MIDDLE LEVEL)

The Tajo de Ronda canyon is unique because it crossing over the thousand-year-old city of Ronda and offer us privileged views of his mythical gorge, his monuments, his antic bridges, his hanging houses, his water mills (...), out of the reach of the simple tourist.

We will have the chance to visit Ronda and some of his important icons, like the main bridge, the Balcony of Romantic Travelers, the hanging gardens, and the old Arabic baths amongst other.

LEVEL-DIFFICULTY: SWIMMING: Yes | RAPEL: 35 m

This canyon had one the more beautiful abseiling of Andalusia, under 30 meters of water falling.

The ones who want to continue the adventure we have an option to finish with a Vía Ferrata in el Tajo.



BUITRERAS | NATURAL PARK OF CORK OAKS TREES (MIDDLE LEVEL)

Situated in the Natural Park of "Los Alcornocales" (The Cork Oaks), the gorge of Las Buitreras constitutes one of the most spectacular natural locations of our region.

REQUIREMENT: Inscription and details of the participants

Due to its special geological formation, the descent of the gorge of Las Buitreras is considered by all, the cathedral of the gorges of Andalucía.

LEVEL-DIFICULTY: DISTANCE: 5.600 m | SLOPE: +390 m / -580 m

There you will enjoy a visual show without precedent in a location situated between rock walls of more than 150 meters.

WALK & WATER TIME ESTIMATE: 5.5 hours

RIO VERDE (HIGHT LEVEL)

Considered one of the most beautiful open canyons of crystalline water of Andalucía the Rio Verde canyon is situated in the Sierra of Almijara, 20 km from Almuñecar and only 50 mins by car from Malaga



MATERIAL NEEDED Swimming trunks, Sport shoes good grip, Cap, Solar Cream, Personal pharmacy, Dry shoes or sandals for the way back

It is an exciting canyon, the adrenaline catching you by surprise in each of its magnificent stretches, with its innumerable abseiling cliffs of up to 14 meters, its fun toboggans, its mystical cascades and its beautiful green reservoirs (...)

SIERRA DE LAS NIEVES | TORRECILLA PEAK (HIGHT LEVEL)

Sierra de las Nieves is an amazing natural reserve with very special biodiversity system due because of his latitude situation, his big variety of soil, his different high levels until 1.919 m and others variables.



MATERIAL NEEDED: Sport shoes | trekking shoes, Cap, Solar Cream, Backpack, Personal pharmacy, Trekking sticks (optional)

FOOD & WATER: 1.5 liters until 75 kg weight, 2 liters from 75 kg. Picnic, fruit, nuts & dried food (...)

REQUIREMENT: Inscription and details of the participants

During this trip we will cross the biggest and the oldest Pinsapo Forest, which just exist in this side of the world and Atlas Mountain. They are old kind of fir tree who had practically disappeared.

LEVEL-DIFFICULTY:

DISTANCE: 17.000 m | SLOPE: +/-1.000 m | WALK Time estimate: 7-8 h

Torrecilla peak is the tower of the western Andalusia and every year we can enjoy hiking until the top with snowshoes. It is the best viewpoint of the Costa del Sol at 35 km distance, Gibraltar point, and the African coast at the other side of the Mediterranean.

DEPARTURE from Marbella: 8.00 am

CORK OAK TREES & GRAZALEMA PARK (ALL LEVELS)

The south of Andalucía possesses natural parks of great landscape beauty, great biological diversity and profound cultural traditions. For decades man has been intimately linked with these spaces, wisely taking advantage of their resources in exchange for protecting and caring for them. With the aid of different routes we will make you part of the history of our land and of the popular culture of our ancestors.

SIERRA NEVADA PARK | PAMPANEIRA-CAPILERIA-BUBION (MIDDLE)

This trekking is placed in the Alpujarras Valleys, the hillside of the incredible National Park of Sierra Nevada (Granada).

It is a very special place where we can breathe a pure and fresh air coming from the highest land of the Iberian Peninsula.



MATERIAL NEEDED: Sport shoes | trekking shoes, Cap, Solar Cream, Backpack, Personal pharmacy, Trekking sticks (optional)
FOOD & WATER: 1.5 liters until 75 kg weight, 2 liters from 75 kg. Picnic, fruit, nuts & dried food (...)
REQUIREMENT: Inscription and details of the participants

During the walk, we will cross 3 beautiful white villages coming from Berbers culture, which inhabited this area after the Moorish invasion. They created villages following the style to which they were accustomed in the mountains of North Africa: narrow, winding streets and small flat-roofed houses. There we will drink in the natural sources placed hundred years ago.

If you have chance, enjoy the typical gastronomy of this region.

ISTAN, WATER WHITE VILLAGE (EASY LEVEL)

White "water village" by antonomasia, Istán has benefited since Moorish times, from the system of irrigation channels, fountains, mills and the best developed plots of land in the whole of our region.



MATERIAL NEEDED: Sport shoes | trekking shoes, Cap, Solar Cream, Backpack, Personal pharmacy, Trekking sticks (optional)

FOOD & WATER: 1.5 liters until 75 kg weight, 2 liters from 75 kg. Picnic, fruit, nuts & dried food (...)

REQUIREMENT: Inscription and details of the participants

Via a walk that takes us along irrigation channels, lanes, agriculture land and through the village streets, we propose a day of cultural hiking, lead by a guide, where we will discover the beautiful landscapes of this village,

LEVEL-DIFFICULTY: DISTANCE: 6.500 m | SLOPE: +/- 200 m

Its water springs and fountains, its ancient history, and the exploitation systems which made it the most prosperous place for centuries.

WALK TIME ESTIMATE: 3 hours TRANSPORT: 20 min from Marbella





THE JUANAR FOREST (EASY LEVEL)

A hiking trail in Sierra Blanca, in a rich and biodiverse environment, accompanied by a mountain guide who will talk about the different types of habitat as we go through them; forests of chestnut trees, stone pines, Aleppo and Canary pine forests, as well as an extensive olive grove.

FOOD & WATER: 1.5 liters until 75 kg weight, 2 liters from 75 kg. Picnic, fruit, nuts & dried food (...)

That is how we will approach Juanar Mirador which offers us across a large valley, magnificent views of Marbella at 700 meters above sea level.

LEVEL-DIFFICULTY: DISTANCE: 3.500 m | SLOPE: +/- 100 m

We have the possibility of finishing this tour in the wine cellars of the homestead of the Marquis de Larios savoring a glass of wine and tasting their tapas.

WALK TIME ESTIMATE: 2 hours TRANSPORT: 20 min from Marbella





PUERTO RICO, CAMINO DEL FARO (MIDDLE LEVEL)

Very close from Marbella this itinerary runs and start into the valley lead into Juanar natural reserve.

After reach Puerto Rico Alto, an antic farm house on top of a peculiar platform, the path turn to the west and cross some valleys on the side of Sierra Blanca Mountain. The different level and hills we will pass through will offer us unusual viewpoints of the city of Marbella.

LEVEL-DIFFICULTY: DISTANCE: 5.600 m | SLOPE: +390 m / -580 m

It is a beautiful trekking around one of the typical landscape of Andalusia.

WALK TIME ESTIMATE: 3 hours TRANSPORT: 5 min from Marbella





JUANAR CROSS PEAK (MIDDLE LEVEL)

Juanar Cross peak is one of the most famous and sought after peak of the Sierra Blanca range with its height of 1.173 meters. It is Marbella's landmark, from where it can be spotted imposing and majestic.



MATERIAL NEEDED: Sport shoes | trekking shoes, Cap, Solar Cream, Backpack, Personal pharmacy, Trekking sticks (optional)

FOOD & WATER: 1.5 liters until 75 kg weight, 2 liters from 75 kg. Picnic, fruit, nuts & dried food (...)

REQUIREMENT: Inscription and details of the participants

With the help of a mountain guide you will reach the summit of this mountain, from where you will enjoy unforgettable views of the whole coast, and if the humidity and atmospheric conditions allow, you will also be able to make out The Strait of Gibraltar and a large fringe of the African coast.

LEVEL-DIFFICULTY: DISTANCE: 7.000 m | SLOPE: +/-450 m

WALK TIME ESTIMATE: 3 hours TRANSPORT: 20 min from Marbella





CROSSING OJEN | MARBELLA (MIDDLE-HIGH LEVEL)

We will start our crossing in the village of Ojen and once crossed the Cerezal Botanical Park we will push out into the tree shaded valley of the hill of Saint Nicolas to land in the Juanar olive grove.

After a rest, we will visit the heart of the Sierra Blanca where lays hidden a rich and diverse ecosystem of humid and dry forests as well as an ancient olive grove.

LEVEL-DIFFICULTY: DISTANCE: 13.500 m | SLOPE: +630/-845 m

After approaching the Juanar Mirador offering us panoramic views over the Costa del Sol, we will initiate the descent meandering through the valley that will take us to Marbella.

A much recommended itinerary.

WALK TIME ESTIMATE: 5-6 hours

TRANSPORT: 15 min from Marbella | 5 min return





LA CONCHA (MIDDLE-HIGH LEVEL)

La Concha is the most famous and sought after peak of the Sierra Blanca range with its height of 1.215 meters. It is Marbella's landmark, from where it can be spotted imposing and majestic.


